

Operation Encompass

Each year, it's important that you are reminded of the work of Operation Encompass. Our school, like all others, is part of Operation Encompass. This is a police and education early intervention safeguarding partnership which stroagus children and young people who experience Domestic Abuse. Operation Encompass means that the Education Safeguarding Service will share information about Domestic Abuse incidents with our school PRIOR to the start of the next school day when the police have been called to a domestic incident. The Operation Encompass information is stored in line with all other confidential safeguarding and child protection information.
