### Uniform

Remember our main colours are blue and grey – and you do not have to buy logo items. Many items can be bought in the supermarket, through 'Natasha's' in the town centre and please don't forget about the Uniform Exchange. Over the course of the year, Natasha's will be introducing the updated school logo – again please don't worry if you have the old logo, it will take time for the new one to come through.

On PE days, children will need to wear their 'PE Uniform' in the school colours – blue joggers/shorts, white t-shirt and a blue jumper/hoodie and plain trainers – please no boots.

We also want children to have a **bookbag** rather than a rucksack. Bookbags can be purchased at the school office.
